Defining Angled USB 3.0 Cable Assemblies

Angled connector hoods help connect USB cables in tight places. L-com now offers two options each for standard A, B and micro B style connectors. The photos below detail the connector position relative to the cable entry direction.


A Style Connectors

For A style connectors, the position of the connector dielectric* is key in determining the correct angle for your application. ***Note:** The connector dielectric is the plastic material that contains the contacts.



B Style Connectors

For B style connectors, the extended hood of the connector is key in determining the correct angle for your application.



For Micro B connectors, the two latches on the connector are key in determining the correct angle for your application. Reference the location of the latches in the photos below:
