### Description

The LCANRBD1067 is a high-quality single-band rubber duck antenna with 3 dBi nominal gain and has a frequency range of 2400 MHz to 2500 MHz. L-com's omnidirectional tilt/swivel blade rubber duck antenna is 5.46 inches tall and 0.39 inches wide.

The LCANRBD1067 rubber duck antenna from L-com features a SMA Male connector with an input VSWR (voltage standing wave ratio) of 2:1.

**Gain:** Antenna's average gain.

**Front to Back Ratio @ 180°±30°:** Average difference between the antenna's maximum gain and the maximum gain in the antenna's back lobe over  $\pm 30^\circ$  angles.

**Cross-polarization Ratio (dB):** Typical difference between the co-polarization and cross-polarization gain across the sector's 3 dB Beam Width.
